- **BTEC Award in Money Skills (Level 1)** – Use money effectively, budget, plan and save in everyday situations and a vocational context

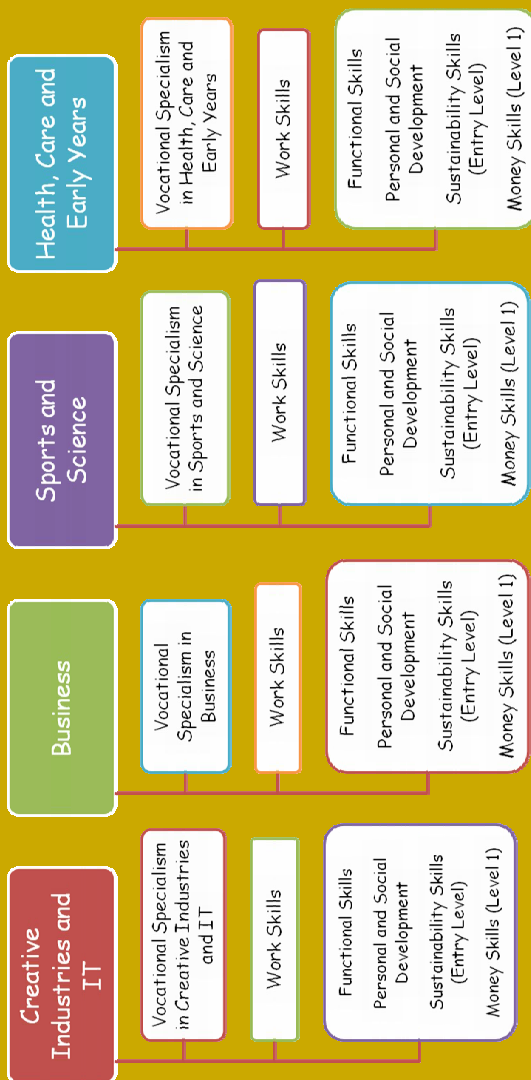
