Entry Requirements for Level 3

Qualifications:

{A Level equivalents}

Learners must have at least 4 GCSEs at grade C or above to include English {or equivalent} or a merit or above at a full level 2 course. For Science, grade C at GCSE Maths {or equivalent} is required. Learners at all levels will be expected to undertake an initial assessment to ascertain they are on the correct level of course
