What does the course involve?

The qualification will give you the knowledge, understanding and competency needed when considering entering employment in the child care profession. You will gain grounding in the essential skills and fundamentals crucial to this area of study, giving you the opportunity to progress to level 3 or enter into your first job within this sector.

It is a mandatory part of the programme to complete 300 hours in an Early Years provision in order to achieve your full programme of study.

As part of your main programme of study you will work towards a qualification in English, Maths or ICT where appropriate.

- You need to have CRB clearance

Entry Requirements for Level 2 Qualifications (GCSE Equivalents):

Learners must have at least 4 GCSEs D-E or above, including English (or the equivalent), and Maths (or the equivalent) where applicable for Science courses, or a merit or above at a full level 1 course.
