Develop the skills that employers want and take the first steps to achieving the success you deserve. If you can say YES to one of the following questions, then you could be eligible for a Pre-Apprenticeship Programme.



- Are you aged 16 to 18 and qualified below Level 3 or aged 19 to 24 and qualified below Level 2?
- Are you aged 16 to 24, unemployed or working fewer than 16 hours a week, and have little work experience?

A Pre-Apprenticeship Programme is an education and training programme with work experience, focused on giving young people aged 16 to 24 the skills and experience that employers are looking for.

Pre-Apprenticeship Programme - what you need to know:

- The Programme includes: Work Preparation Training (Employability Qualification), English and Maths, Work Placement (minimum 1 day, up to 3 days a week), Attendance at College, 2 days a week for 26 weeks (9am to 4pm).
- Pre-Apprenticeship Programmes are for young people aged 16 to 24 inclusive, with certain criteria
- You could be eligible for a Pre-Apprenticeship programme if you are unemployed, or work fewer than 16 hours per week, and have little work experience
- Pre-Apprenticeship Programmes are designed for motivated individuals who think they could be ready for employment or an Apprenticeship within six months of engaging in the programme
- At the end of the Pre-Apprenticeship programme you will be offered support regarding progression to the next stage of your career
- Although your work experience will be unpaid, the main importance to you will be gaining skills within a working environment. This will help you to work towards a full time Apprenticeship and these qualities and skills will be essential for your CV.
