

VENUE AND DURATION OF COURSE:

10 weeks starting on Wednesday 5 May 2021 at 16:00 – 18:00. This course will be at John Ruskin College, Selsdon Park Road, Croydon or remote

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

There are no specific entry requirements for this qualification. You will be assessed prior to starting to the programme with a pre-requisite checklist to determine the competency level and the programme you will complete.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

BTEC Level 1 Digital Skills.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The skills that you will develop on this course will help you discover the practices involved in digital skills and how to apply this knowledge and these skills in common situations. It will enable you to develop digital communication skills and enable adults to develop their knowledge and skills to use in their personal lives, or to support them in their careers.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- Using devices and handling information
- Creating and editing
- Communicating
- Transacting
- Being safe and responsible online

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

Level 1 will consist of two externally set and internally marked assessments. This will consist of one task based assessment (1hr 45 mins) and one question paper (25 mins).

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

- Pens/pencils
- Notepad

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

The qualification is graded to a Pass. All mandatory units must be passed. This qualification will lead to enhanced knowledge of essential digital skills within the workplace.

COURSE FEE:

If you are aged 19+ this qualification is free subject to eligibility and skills scan. Please contact Client Services for advice and guidance on funding and eligibility.
