

DURATION, DAY, DATE AND TIME OF THE COURSE:

10 weeks starting on Monday 19 April 2021, 16:00 – 18:00.

VENUE:

PRIOR KNOWLEDGE/SKILLS REQUIRED:

There are no specific entry requirements for this qualification. You will be assessed at the start of the programme with an online Maths assessment to determine prior knowledge and competency level in Maths.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

You will receive a College certificate of completion.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The course will develop your knowledge and confidence in Maths. Whether you are a novice in Maths or simply looking to brush up on forgotten skills, this course will cover the key concepts and practical applications of maths. Discover most up-to-date techniques in calculations both with and without a calculator. This is a supportive course for those involved with home-learning or for those considering starting a maths qualification.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- Century: An online learning platform
- Methods of calculator and non-calculator problem solving
- Four functions of maths & order of calculation
- Fractions, Decimals and Percentages
- Introduction to Algebra, Graphs and Data

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

There will be an online assessment of Maths at start and end of the course using Century.

- Scientific calculator
- Notepad & pen/pencil

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

The course can lead to the next level of one of the adult courses we provide such as Functional Skills or GCSE Maths courses running from September 2021 and the chance to progress to an approved Functional Skills exam.
