

VENUE AND DURATION OF COURSE:

John Ruskin College, Selsdon Park Road, South Croydon, CR2 8JJ, 1 year, Full-time.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- Hair and Media Make-up Level 2 Diploma, Art Level 3 or an Art A-Level and GCSE grade 9-4 (A*-C) in English and Maths.
- Willingness to follow uniform guidelines and comply with college attendance and punctuality.
- Candidates will need to be able to practise at home and provide clients for assessment.
- Candidates who are pregnant or suffer from asthma will need to be risk assessed due to the use of hazardous chemicals.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Level 3 Diploma in Fashion & Media Make-Up.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The VTCT Level 3 Diploma in Fashion, Theatre and Media Hair and Make-Up (QCF) is a technical level qualification that provides students with the knowledge, understanding and skills to work as a make-up artist. This qualification is based on Habia National Occupational Standards (NOS). This qualification is recognised by the UK's largest beauty therapy trade body/professional association, The Federation of Holistic Therapists (FHT), and also the UK's second largest association representing beauty therapy employers, the British Association of Beauty Therapy and Cosmetology (BABTAC), as being fit for purpose for preparing students for a career as a make-up artist.

This qualification has specifically been designed for the 16-19 age groups and builds on existing knowledge and understanding of make-up artistry gained at Level 2, enabling students to expand the scope of their technical skills to prepare students for employment as a make-up artist.

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

A portfolio of practical work, photographic evidence, exams and assignments.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

- Airbase training course – approximately £38.00.
- Brush kit required.
