

VENUE AND DURATION OF COURSE:

John Ruskin College, Selsdon Park Road, South Croydon, CR2 8JJ, 1 year Full-time, 3 days per week.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Five GCSEs grade 9-4 (A*-C), that include English and Maths or a Level 2 Diploma at Merit/Distinction and GCSE English and Maths grade 9-4 (A*-C).

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

- Year 1: Level 3 Diploma in Creative Media Production & Technology
- Year 2: Level 3 Extended Diploma in Creative Media Production & Technology

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The Extended Diploma in Creative Media is a creative, vocational and challenging course. It provides a broad hands-on introduction to the business of media production. Students will have the opportunity to use industry-standard cameras, sound recording equipment, lighting kit and software to develop projects in a variety of media disciplines. We also provide all the support and guidance needed for UCAS applications.

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

Formative assessment will take place during projects in one to one and group tutorials, peer assessment and presentations. At the end of each project, a formal summative assessment and progress review will take place.

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

The course is equivalent to three A-Levels and will provide a pathway to further study at degree level, or to employment in the media industry.
