WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Level 2 Diploma in Music Performance and Production UAL

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

You will take part in a variety of projects linked to Music performance and Music production, through practical workshops, performances and rehearsals, recording, sequencing projects, lectures and classroom taught sessions as well as independent study.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- Introduction to music performance
- Introduction to music production
- Listening skills for music performance and production
- Exploring music composition
- Contextual research for music performance and production
- Music Performance Skills and Practice
- Music Production Skills and Practice
- Music Performance and Production project
- English and Maths (if not already achieved at GCSE grade 9-4/A*-C)

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

You will be assessed continually through practical project work, coursework, written assignments and through giving presentations. Practical assessment will include some public performances but also in-class presentation and workshop assessment.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

Access to your own instrument if you are a performer would be desirable.

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

- Apply to progress onto the Level 3 Diploma in Performing Arts/ Level 3 Diploma in Music or Level 3 Extended Diploma in Creative Media Production & Technology if you have achieved a Merit, or Distinction overall at the end of your Level 2 course.
- Enter a Performing Arts related career in music.
- Music industry Apprenticeships
- Employment in sound engineering or computer-based music production
