

#### VENUE AND DURATION OF COURSE:

John Ruskin College, Selsdon Park Road, South Croydon, CR2 8JJ, 1 year, Full-time.

#### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- A Level in Art, or an artistic background and evidence of work in a portfolio, or progression from Art courses at Level 2
- 5 GCSEs at Grade 9-4 (A\*-C) or equivalent to include English
- You may also progress on to this course from Level 2 Hairdressing or Level 2 Hair & Media Make-Up
- You will be required to produce a positive reference from your tutor
- Willingness to follow uniform guidelines and comply with college attendance and punctuality
- Candidates will need to be able to practise at home and provide clients for assessment
- Candidates who are pregnant or suffer from asthma will need to be risk assessed due to the use of hazardous chemicals

#### WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Level 3 Diploma in Theatrical, Special Effects & Media Make-Up.

#### COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This is for professional make-up artists and hairdressers specialising in theatrical and special effects make up, including prosthetics and hair styling. This qualification will enable you to gain skills, knowledge and understanding required in order to perform a range of make-up and hair services in the performance arts, fashion and media sectors. Extensive research, practise and innovation are needed to be successful in this area. You will produce avant-garde and commercial looks, including the hair styling and costumes to complement your make-up design. This largely practical course also covers health and safety and the promotion of services and products. You will also be expected to participate in relevant work experience.

#### UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- Media Make-Up (special effects)
- Camouflage make-up
- Fashion and photographic make-up
- Cosmetic make-up science
- Style and fit postiche (wigs, facial hair and hairpieces)
- Apply airbrush make-up to the face and body
- False eyelash application
- Anatomy and physiology for make-up services

**TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:**

A portfolio of practical work, photographic evidence, exams and assignments.

**EQUIPMENT NEEDED:**

- John Ruskin College uniform is required – approximately £50.00
- A specific kit of equipment is required – approximately £900.00
- A specialised brush kit will need to be purchased later in the year – approximately £50.00
- Purchase of photographs for portfolio – approximately £130.00
