COURSE DESCRIPTION:

During this course, you will be able to develop your practical techniques in a broad range of women's hairdressing skills to become a junior stylist. The course will involve both practical and theory classes. During the practical lessons, you will work in a realistic salon environment and will be expected to carry out hairdressing services on clients, once you have reached a certain level of ability.

- Shampoo & condition hair
- Colour & lighten hair
