Five GCSEs grade 9-3 (A*-D) including English and Maths.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

- City & Guilds Air Cabin Crew Level 2 Diploma
- GCSEs in English or Maths (for those who have not achieved Grade C or above)

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course has been designed especially for those who wish to pursue a career in the airline industry as cabin crew. Within the civil aviation industry, cabin crew play a vital role in securing the safety and comfort of airline passengers. As such, it is important that airline cabin crew are appropriately trained for the job.

This qualification can help you secure your first job working in a cabin crew team. You will learn how to co-ordinate a safe flight; preparing the cabin, getting the passengers on board, demonstrating safety procedures, as well as learning how to deal with emergencies.

This course is ideal for those seeking employment or for those wishing to enhance their studies in Travel and Tourism as the qualification provides a realistic description of the work carried out by airline cabin crew. Given our close proximity to Gatwick, the second largest airport in the UK, these subjects are of direct relevance to future employment in the area.
