

VENUE AND DURATION OF COURSE:

John Ruskin College, Selsdon Park Road, South Croydon, CR2 8JJ, 1 year full-time.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

GCSE grade 2 (E) in English and Maths; or Functional Skills Entry Level 3. Alternatively you may have successfully completed a vocational qualification at Level 1 or Entry Level 3.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Level 1 Diploma in African Caribbean Hairdressing.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This foundation course is essential for all potential hairdressers as it provides a strong base from which to develop other skills at a higher level. You will develop your basic hairdressing skills and assist stylists in hairdressing salon including shampooing, conditioning, styling, colouring, reception health and safety. You will also produce a portfolio evidence file.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- Follow health and safety
- Introduction to the hair and beauty sector
- Working with others in the hair and beauty sector
- Presenting a professional image in the salon
- Shampooing
- Basic colouring using temporary colour
- Styling and finishing
- The art of dressing hair
- Create a hair and beauty image
- Reception
- Create and maintain retail displays in the salon
- Style and finish African type hair

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

A combination of practical observation, assessment of practical tasks, assignments, written and oral tests and the compilation of a portfolio of evidence. Students develop skills in our public hairdressing salon. However you are encouraged to work in local salons at weekends and the college may be able to help in finding such work. Any experience gained in this way can help the learner in speeding up their collection of evidence.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

Uniform and hairdressing kit essential.

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

This course will prepare you for entry into employment at a basic level in local salons or for progression to study the NVQ 2 Hairdressing or Afro-Caribbean Hairdressing Level 2

COURSE FEE:

If you are under 19 on 31/08/2023, tuition is free. If you are 19 or over, please consult Client Services for advice and guidance on funding and eligibility.

Please be aware that there may be additional costs for equipment and educational visits. This information will be available from the curriculum staff at interview.
