

VENUE AND DURATION OF COURSE:

John Ruskin College, Selsdon Park Road, South Croydon, CR2 8JJ, 1 year Full-time.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Five GCSEs grade 9-3 (A*-D) including English and Maths.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Travel and Tourism - Level 2 Diploma.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course has been designed especially for those who wish to pursue a career in the Travel and Tourism Industry. The course will provide you with a broad knowledge and understanding of the sector and equip you with the right skills to pursue a variety of different career opportunities in this interesting and challenging industry. Students on this course will benefit from the opportunity of attending site visits to various organisations and events, to see first-hand the exciting opportunities the industry has to offer.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

The Level 2 Diploma consists of two mandatory units and six optional units. You will be required to undertake GCSE retakes (English & Maths), if you have not yet achieved A*-C in these areas. Students will also participate in Work Experience outside of their normal college days.

- Unit 204 Interpersonal skills for the travel and tourism workplace
- Unit 227 Principles of customer service in hospitality, leisure, travel and tourism

Optional Units

- Unit 201 Worldwide travel and tourism destinations
- Unit 203 Customer service and selling skills for travel and tourism
- Unit 206 The structure of the UK travel industry
- Unit 213 Visitor attractions
- Unit 214 Resort representatives
- Unit 215 Responsible tourism

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

Unit 201 will be externally assessed with an online exam. All other units are formally assessed by completed assignment work to meet deadlines.

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

Obtaining a merit or above in this course will allow you to move on to BTEC Level 3 Extended Diploma in Travel and Tourism or employment at a junior level.
