This course takes place at John Ruskin College, Selsdon Park Road, South Croydon CR2 8JJ; and runs for one year (34 weeks).

A Level 1 qualification.

ASSESSMENT METHOD:

Coursework.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

Get Ready is a one year programme which contains the following elements to support this:

- Maths and English qualifications if needed

- Certificate in Personal and Social Skills including topics such as teamwork, dealing with problems, managing relationships, and skills such as personal finances, community action and preparation for work
- Tutorial and enrichment
- Work experience

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

Once students have successfully completed this introductory course they will, depending on their tutor reference, be able to progress at the College on to vocationally focussed Level 1 courses.
