

VENUE AND DURATION OF COURSE:

John Ruskin College, Selsdon Park Road, South Croydon, CR2 8JJ, 1 year full-time.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

5 GCSE grade 9-3 (A*-D) including English and Maths; or Level 1 Diploma (merit/distinction) including GCSE grade 9-3 (A*-D) in English and Maths.

PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCIES FOR THIS COURSE:

- Knowledge of how the body works in relation to sport and exercise
- Ability to show respect and honesty towards others
- Responsibility for own behaviour
- Effective verbal and non-verbal communication skills during coaching and instruction sessions
- Excellent time keeping (punctuality and attendance)
- Ability to work individually and as a team
- Ability to reflect on own practice for development of their instructional and coaching skills
- Ability to demonstrate own initiative and think on your feet
- Keen interest in the subject and up to date with current practices in sport and exercise e.g. ACSM (American College of Sports Medicine), Sport England, BBC Sport
- Leadership and team working skills – the ability to work well with others

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Sport – Level 2 Extended Certificate.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is designed to develop your skills and knowledge in the areas of coaching, fitness instruction and the effects of exercise on the body. You will learn how to plan and organise a sports event and run it efficiently. You will also improve your practical sports skills. This qualification will give you experience in a wide range of skills from teamwork and communication to being able to assess someone's level of fitness.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- Coaching
- How to plan and organise a sports event
- Anatomy and physiology
- Fitness for sport and exercise
- Practical sport

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

A combination of coursework and practical assessments, as well as 2 externally assessed exams.
